2. Protest and appeals of questions from the written examination for the position of Fire Captain administered on March 20, 2023.
3. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval of the eligibility list for the position of Fire Captain created from examination administered on March 20, 2023. This eligibility list will remain in existence for one year beginning on the first day of the month following the month the written examination was given or until the list is exhausted. If changes are made to the examination as a

result of the Appeals Hearing, this item will be tabled, and an amended eligibility list will be certified at a subsequent Commission Meeting.

4. Notice of SAPD and SAFD disciplinary suspensions without pay:
 - a. A one (1) day suspension for Officer Vincent S. Aceituno effective March 20, 2023.
 - b. An agreed thirty (30) day suspension for Officer Michael Le effective March 14, 2023.
 - c. A one (1) day suspension for Fire Engineer Ryan Edwards effective March 27, 2023.

These matters have not been appealed and are therefore final.

d. An indefinite suspension for Officer Miguel A. Leal effective March 21, 2023. A letter of appeal was received on March 22, 2023.
