#### Approval of Minutes

#### Briefing and Possible Action on the following items

2. Protest and appeals of questions from the written examination for the position of Police Sergeant administered on March 28, 2024.
3. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval of the eligibility list for the position of Police Sergeant created from examination administered on March 28, 2024. This eligibility list will be valid for a period of one (1) year after the date on which the written examination was given or until the list is exhausted. If changes are made to the examination as a result of the Appeals Hearing, this item will be tabled, and an amended eligibility list will be certified at a subsequent Commission Meeting.

4. Notice of SAPD disciplinary suspensions without pay:
  - a. An agreed fifteen (15) day suspension for Officer Steven D. Rivas effective March 28, 2024.
  - b. A one (1) day suspension for Officer Warren G. Zepeda effective March 28, 2024.
  - c. An indefinite suspension for Officer Levon B. Harrison effective April 2, 2024.

These matters have not been appealed and are therefore final.
